



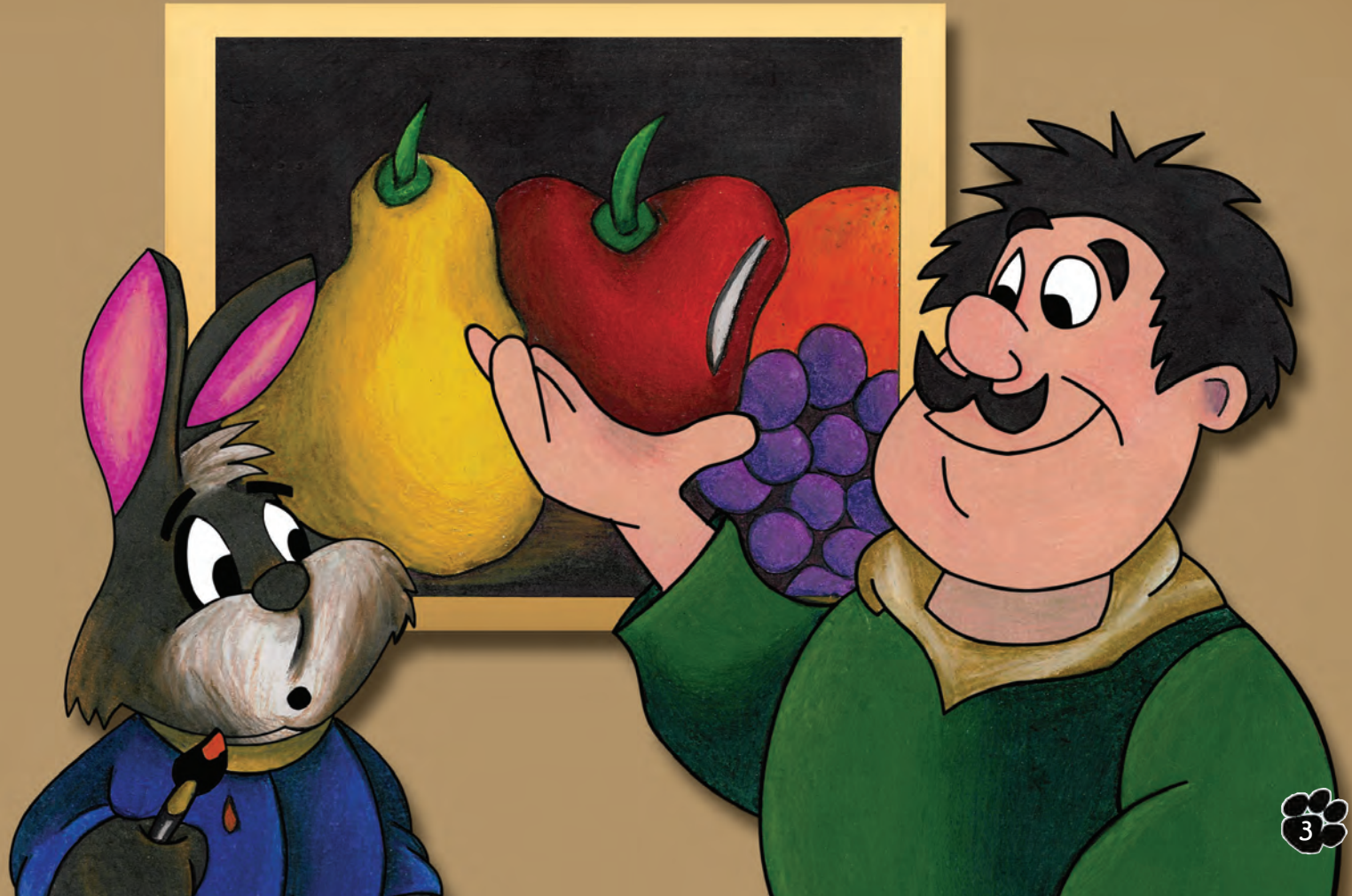
Michelangelo Bunnyrroti,
